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State Representative Justin Rodriguez files for re-election

San Antonio, TX – Today, State Representative Justin Rodriguez filed for re-election to the Texas House of Representatives at the Bexar County Democratic Party Headquarters. Rodriguez is seeking his second term representing the west and northwest sides of San Antonio, including the City of Leon Valley.

“I am proud of what we were able to achieve during my first term,” Rodriguez said. “But there is still a lot more work that needs to be done.”

Rodriguez passed four bills during his first session, one of which calls for the formation of an interim committee to evaluate how we select judges in Texas. In addition to his legislative successes in Austin, Rodriguez held numerous community events including two town hall meetings, a school supply and backpack give away, and a health fair.

“Although the legislative session was long, I did not let that keep me away from trying to make a difference in the daily lives of my constituents back home,” Rodriguez said. “I know that I passed some good bills but, more importantly, I’m proud that we were able to be a resource to the people in House District 125. I look forward to building upon what we’ve started and continuing my work in a second term.”

In his freshman term, Rodriguez served on the Public Education and Urban Affairs Committees and was named a Deputy Democratic Whip.
