## **KYLE KACAL ANNOUNCES HIS RE-ELECTION CAMPAIGN**

COLLEGE STATION, TEXAS —Today, State Rep. Kyle Kacal (R-College Station) announced his intention to seek re-election to the Texas House of Representatives.

“It is an honor and a privilege to serve the people of House District 12, and it is with great humility and excitement that I announce my plans to seek re-election,” Kacal said. “I am proud of the many conservative accomplishments of the 84th Legislature, but we must continue the fight to protect the values we cherish.”

During his second legislative session, Rep. Kacal was appointed to the House Committees on Natural Resources, Environmental Regulation and served as Vice Chair of the House Committee on Rules and Resolutions. Rep. Kacal coauthored and supported border security enhancements, tax cuts, and open carry legislation. “These measures address many concerns expressed by the citizens of House District 12 during the last election,” said Kacal. “In the coming months, I look forward to meeting with constituents, discussing these measures and the future of Texas.”

Rep. Kacal also touted many of his own legislative accomplishments, including tougher storage and reporting requirements for ammonium nitrate to prevent another deadly disaster like the 2013 West, Texas fertilizer plant explosion. In addition, Rep. Kacal authored HB 21, which gives terminally ill patients access to potentially life saving drugs that have passed the Phase 1 FDA trials.
