CHART WESTCOTT CAMPAIGN RAISES OVER \$700,000 IN FORTY-FIVE DAYS

Dallas - Conservative Republican Chart Westcott raised \$736,559 for the campaign finance reporting period that ended June 30th in a report that was filed with the Texas Ethics Commission last week. After filing paperwork with the Ethics Commission on May 14th of this year, more than 320 people donated to the Chart Westcott campaign during this period.
